



After a hugely successful redevelopment project completed in 2021, RAC Esperance Holiday Park is undergoing an expansion which will see increased guest amenity and accommodation options. Modular WA was selected as supplier of modular buildings for the 2024 expansion.

Solutions

The project demanded strict adherence to schedules to mitigate disruption during peak holiday periods, with off-site prefabrication reducing on-site construction time and preserving park operations. Environmental and heritage preservation were priorities for the client, and Modular WA teams operated under a tightly managed on-site project plan intended to streamline installation and mitigate site disruption.

Precision planning and proactive project management were crucial in avoiding delays, highlighting an ability to navigate complexities while enhancing guest satisfaction and the park's offerings. By adhering to timelines, minimizing site impact, managing traffic effectively, and implementing a well-developed methodology, Modular WA delivered solutions that ensured success and improved the park's accommodation options.







Client: Southwest Resorts

Design, construct and deliver a series of cyclonic-rated modular facility buildings.

In early 2019, Southwest Resorts called on design proposals which would expand the existing amenity facilities at their busy, popular tourist park. Modular WA undertook extensive collaborative design development with the client, commencing construction in October the same year.

Solutions

The end product was a series of facilities designed to integrated seamlessly not only with the existing buildings, but with their picturesque coastal surroundings. With meticulous site planning, we were able to install the new buildings without damaging surrounding infrastructure and with minimal impact to the park's busy operations.

The project included hydraulic design to suit both potable salinated and bore water services, undercover ducted commercial gas, and all AS1428.1 accessibility provisions. Particular attention was paid to functionality, with a focus on creating a space that would adequately service the park through seasonal activity fluxes and over a long-term lifespan.









Client: Rio Tinto

Design, construct, and deliver facility buildings as part of the Stage 2-B Expansion at Jerriwah Village. Buildings included a Gymnasium, Laundry Hub with Kitchenette, Foyer and Cleaner's Store.

Scope included the supply of furniture and fitout of equipment such as commercial grade appliances and specialised, high-traffic gym equipment 2023 - 2024

PROJECT PROFILE





Client: Rio Tinto

Design, construct, and deliver facility buildings to accommodate transiting personnel at mine site locations throughout the Pilbara region.

High level project management was essential to ensure delivery in line with the client's expectations. After demonstrating impressive workmanship with the Brockman 2 project, the company was then awarded further orders for the Hope Downs 1, Hope Downs 4, and West Angelas sites.

Solutions

Detailed scheduling and extensive project management was required to ensure a contract of this scale and complexity was delivered smoothly. The scale of the buildings in Brockman 2 ranged from 14 - 42 metres long. Transport was carried out over the course of a few days as the buildings were gradually dissembled as each module was loaded.

A dedicated project team with its own yard & office was established and regular project meetings were held with relevant stakeholders. Stringent testing took place prior to transport ensuring all emergency service utilities, data cabling, service maintenance points, and HVAC systems were fault free and fully operational as per the relevant commercial standards.









Client: Crothers Constructions / Department of Biodiversity

Design, construct, and deliver facility building including all external structures, fitout and furniture.

In 2019, the Department (DBCA) called for an expansion to its conservation management facilities in the popular tourist destination Monkey Mia. Modular WA was subcontracted by Crothers Construction to supply the architecturally designed Ranger Station facility building.

Solutions

The specification and methodology were developed collaboratively with the project architect to ensure the structure's longevity, considering cyclonic risk and its extreme proximity to the coast. A complex roof structure required careful attention and resulted in the use of a large box gutter system to control water run off during severe weather events.

Despite a tight timeline and winter weather conditions, our expert team was able to employ effective procurement, scheduling and safe work practices to deliver a quality commercial building that was designed to be highly durable and fit-for-purpose.







Client: Shire of Yalgoo

Design and install a modular solution with a significant visual impact and sense of connectedness to the community.

In collaboration with Core Business Australia and the Shire of Yalgoo, an ambitious vision for an aesthetically striking sports centre was realised. A community open day was held with a GNWFL exhibition match on the new grounds to celebrate the project's successful execution.

Solutions

In order to invigorate the town and encourage community engagement, Modular WA's design team worked closely with the client to produce a visually stunning solution that incorporated corrugated steel, timber columns and copper accents. This along with commissioned LED-lit artwork paid homage to the town's culture and the surrounding Western Australian outback.

Exceptional scheduling and control of onsite contractors was required to ensure the project was completed without delay in the extremely isolated area. Despite working over challenging summer months, our team delivered the project ahead of schedule to a satisfied client.

Installing modular homes within a residential village always requires highly detailed planning due to the restrictions faced when installing multiple modules onto tightly fit blocks. Modular WA works extensively with our expert transport and logistics specialists so that installations are carried out ensuring maximum cost efficiency and minimal disruption to the site.

Careful lot rollout scheduling is carried out in conjunction with design personnel and village planners to ensure a smooth growth of the village in a way which allows transport teams to deliver the homes in the most efficient way possible, reducing the risk of potential complications.

Solutions

As sites vary in location and are subject to multiple specifications, comprehensive understanding of each project is required. Delivering homes for the panel is far from a "one-size-fits-all" methodology. Expert project planning and scheduling is essential to adhere to the program's stringent timeframes. Constant performance updates via weekly project meetings are held with stakeholders to ensure all packages are on-track for delivery.

Modular WA was the first builder to successfully deliver homes as part of the modular program and as of 2023 has completed packages in Tom Price, Collie, Geraldton, East Bunbury and Albany - with further orders underway.

Solutions

This project required extensive design development in order to satisfy the client's high expectations. With a look towards long-term investment in both its staff and the local township, the client was looking for a premium solution that would encourage staff to relocate and become a part of the local community.

The result were generously sized homes with a strong focus on outdoor lifestyles including high end features such as boat storage, outdoor kitchens, and swimming pools. Under concrete provisions were made to enable entertainment and TV's to be enjoyed from Alfresco areas.

Multiple configurations were developed to increase visual diversity, while selections were made with local environmental conditions in mind. Exceptionally designed living spaces benefited further from raking ceilings creating an internally expansive feel, with luxury touches such as bi-fold doors, walk-in robes, and dual vanities.
